Chapter: Classroom Communication

Teaching is clear, warm, two-way communication.

Verbal - Clear words, good pace, encouraging tone.

Nonverbal - Face, posture, eye contact, energy - students read it constantly.

Clear instructions - One step at a time; check for understanding.

Open questions - Make students think; give wait time.

Feedback - Specific, timely, on the work; corrections given privately.

Confused students - Go quiet, not loud - so check understanding.
